# Annual Report on the National Skill Test 2017

## New certificates issued for 330,000 Skilled Professionals in Japan

The Ministry has published the annual report of National Skill Test in 2017 fiscal year (April 2017-March 2018). As a result, the number of successful applicants, i.e., Certified Skilled Professionals, is 328,778 in FY 2017, increased by 25,234 (8.3%) from FY 2016.

National Skill Test system is to qualify the extent of professional skills that should be gained or required for working, and is now conducted by 130 job categories. Those who have successfully passed the test may refer to themselves as "Certified Skilled Professionals" by the Human Resources Development Promotion Act. In the accumulated total since the system started in 1959, about 6.7 million people are qualified as "Certified Skilled Professionals".

## SUMMARY

- Overall number of applicants is 784,048, increased by 26,668(3.5%) from the previous year
- Overall number of successful applicants is 328,778, increased by 25,234(8.3%) from the previous year
  - $\diamond$  The passing rate\* is 41.9%, roughly the same as previous year (40.1%)
  - $\diamond$  The cumulative number of successful applicants is 6,649,982 since the system started
- Of all job categories, financial planning is the most: 467,876 applicants
- Among the grades, grade 2 (upper grade) is the most: 334,364 applicants




## 2. Changes in the number of applicants by grade in past 6 years

## **About National Skill Test**

## 1. Overview

National skill test is a skill evaluation system implemented by Government of Japan to test and certify the extent of skills that workers have in order to improve their skills and social status according to the Human Resources Development Promotion Act.

National skill test has been held since 1959, and about 780 thousand applied for the test and about 330 thousand successfully passed the test in Fiscal Year 2017. In the accumulated total since the system started, about 6.65 million people are qualified as certified skilled professionals.

## 2. Implementation of national skill test

The Minister of Health, Labour and Welfare implements national skill test by classifying grades specified by an Ordinance of the Minister of Health, Labour and Welfare for each of the job categories specified by a Cabinet Order in practical and theoretical examinations.

Number of job categories is 130 as of 23<sup>th</sup> July, 2018. Each job category is yearly reviewed, such as newly establish or reorganize the job categories and operations, or rebuild the examination standards, to catch up to the demands of the time.

The certified skilled professionals have three grades, Grade 1 (the highest grade), Grade 2 (upper grade) and Grade 3 (middle grade), in addition to Special Grade (management) for some industrial job categories and Basic Grade 1, 2 and Basic grade exclusively for foreign trainees. Some job categories have only one grade called Grade solo (the highest grade) instead of the three-grade policy.

## 3. Structure for the implementation of National Skill Test System

Each Prefectural Governor conducts the national skill test based on the annual plan formulated by the Minister of Health, Labour and Welfare, and the Japan Vocational Ability Development Association prepares the examination questions. Some operational work such as accepting application and conducting examinations is implemented by Prefectural Vocational Ability Development Associations at Governors' request.

It is to be noted that 19 job categories such as financial planning are conducted by designated examining bodies, designated by the Minister of Health, Labour and Welfare.

### 4. Certification to the passed examinees

Those who have passed a national skill test are entitled to refer to themselves as certified skilled professionals, according to the Human Resources Development Promotion Act.

The certificates of Special Grade, Grade 1 and Grade solo are issued by the Minister of Health, Labour and Welfare whereas those of other grades by Prefectural Governors or representatives of the designated examining body.
