

Information about the Medical Expense Support Program for Overseas Atomic Bomb Survivors

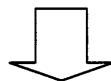

Through the Medical Expense Support Program for Overseas Atomic Bomb Survivors;

The limit on reimbursements for the medical expenses of the year, which was previously 176,000 yen (or 187,000 yen in the case where you have been hospitalized for 4 days running or longer) in 2012, has been revised as below. The revision will apply to the medical expenses you paid during the 12 months from January to December 2013.

- The limit on annual reimbursements for the previous year (2012)

176,000 yen (or 187,000 yen in the case where you have been hospitalized for 4 days running or longer)



- The limit on reimbursements for the medical expenses you paid during the 12 months from January to December 2013

179,000 yen (or **191,000 yen** in the case where you have been hospitalized for 4 days running or longer)
