  - (1) Feeding control (herein after including the management of records of the animals and their breeding, shipment and death) and sanitary control are carried out under the supervision of a committee consisting of members concerned including veterinarians in the establishment.
  - (2) Appropriate measures are taken to ensure that the intrusion of animals from the outside is prevented.
  - (3) When introduced into the establishment, the animals are confirmed not to be contaminated with the pathogens of infectious disease in order to prevent the intrusion of infectious disease that may infect humans through animals.
  - (4) Examinations are conducted periodically on all the animals stored in the establishment to confirm that they are not contaminated with pathogens of infectious disease.
  - (5) Information concerning the feeding and sanitary controls of the animals is recorded in documents and such documents are retained.
2. Since birth, the animals have not been used in any study with pathogens of infectious disease or have not come in contact with any animal used in such a study.
