Outline of the Survey

1. Objective

The objective of this survey is to grasp the structure and content of long-term care (LTC) services provided nationwide and thereby provide a basis for improving the LTC service infrastructure from the viewpoint of service provision.

2. Coverage and Objects

This survey covered the following institutions and establishments nationwide under the Long-Term Care Insurance System, and all of them are the object: 'Establishments providing in-home services for preventive LTC', 'Establishments providing community-based preventive LTC services, 'Establishments providing assistance in receiving preventive LTC', 'Establishments providing in-home services', 'Establishments providing community-based services', Establishments providing assistance in receiving in-home LTC', and 'Institutions covered by the long-term care insurance' [It excludes 'Home-visit rehabilitation service (for preventive LTC)', 'Management and guidance for in-home recuperative care (for preventive LTC), and deemed Home-visit nursing care (for preventive LTC) and deemed Commuting rehabilitation service (for preventive LTC) provided by medical institutions〕.



Managers of 'Institutions covered by the long-term care insurance', 'Establishments providing in-home services, and 'Establishments providing assistance in receiving in-home long-term care' etc. filled in the questionnaires.

Until the 2008 survey, the questionnaires had been distributed and collected by prefectures, designated cities and core cities (some of them had been distributed by mail), and from the 2009 survey, a private company commissioned by MHLW has distributed and collected the questionnaires by mail.
