

## Outline of Survey

### 1 Objective

To capture the system and content of long-term care service provision nationwide, and thereby to obtain basic data on infrastructure developments considered important by long-term care service providers.

### 2 Coverage and Subject

The coverage was set for establishments providing home-based services for preventive long-term care, establishments providing community-based services for preventive long-term care, establishments providing assistance in receiving preventive long-term care, establishments providing home-based services, establishments providing community-based services, establishments providing assistance in receiving home-based long-term care, and institutions covered by long-term care insurance, within the national long-term care insurance system, and all such institutions and establishments are taken as subjects (except home-visit rehabilitation (for preventive long-term care), home-based recuperative care control and instruction (for preventive long-term care), and home-visit nursing care (for preventive long-term care) and daycare rehabilitation (for preventive long-term care)) provided by medical institutions as deemed designation services.

#### (1) Institutions covered by long-term care insurance

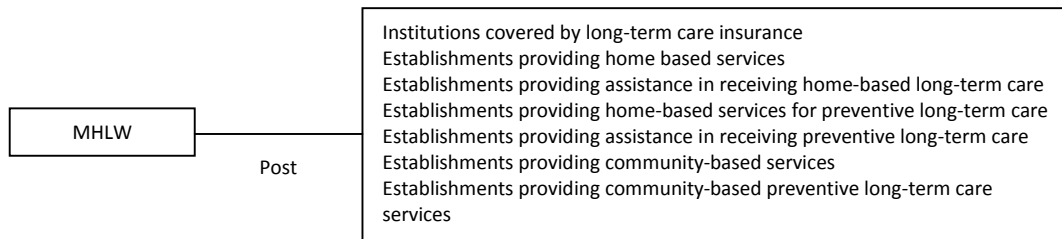
Establishment and management entity, capacity, number of residents, number of employees, details of rooms, etc.

#### (2) Establishments providing home-based services etc.

Establishment and management entity, number of recipients, number of employees, etc.

### 5 Survey Method and Organization

Questionnaires were filled in by managers of institutions covered by long-term care insurance, establishments providing home-based services, establishments providing assistance in receiving home-based long-term care, etc.



**\*Method and organization**

Until the 2008 survey, the questionnaires were distributed and collected by prefectures, designated cities and core cities (with some distributed by post), and from the 2009 survey, a private company commissioned by MHLW has distributed and collected the questionnaires by post.

**6 Tabulation of Results**

Results were tabulated by the Statistics and Information Department of the Minister's Secretariat of the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare.

- (2) Only those responding institutions and establishments which are active were tabulated.
- (3) As figures in the outline are rounded, totals of breakdowns may not agree with the total.
- (4) The figure for the number of institutions and establishments is as of October 1st, and the figure for the number of recipients is for the month of September.

However, figures for numbers of recipients or residents in the following institutions and establishments are as of midnight September 30th.

- Institutions covered by long-term care insurance, and community-based welfare facilities for the elderly requiring long-term care.
- Establishments providing preventive long-term care for residents of specified institutions, and establishments providing long-term care for residents of specified facilities.
- Establishments providing preventive long-term care for the elderly with dementia in residential care settings, and establishments providing long-term care for the elderly with dementia in residential care settings.
- Establishments providing community-based long-term care for residents of specified facilities.

- (5) Establishments providing multiple services are included as separate establishments for each service provided. For example, an establishment providing preventive long-term care services and long-term care services would be included as an individual establishment for each of the services provided.
- (6) No surveys were made of institutions or establishments located in the regions affected by the Great East Japan Earthquake (municipalities including areas flooded by the tsunami and areas on alert due to the incident at TEPCO Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant) (2,131 institutions and establishments).
