Restriction of distribution of foods based on the Act on Special Measures Concerning Nuclear
Emergency Preparedness, direction of Director-General of the Nuclear Emergency Response
Headquarters

Today, based on the results of inspections conducted until yesterday, the Nuclear Emergency Response Headquarters has issued the restriction of distribution of Wild mushrooms collected in Karuizawa-machi and Miyota-machi for Governor of Nagano.

1. With regard to Nagano prefecture, the restriction of distribution of Wild mushrooms collected in Karuizawa-machi, and Miyota-machi is instructed today.
 - (1) The Instruction of the Nuclear Emergency Response Headquarters is attached as attachment 1.
 - (2) The concept of management at Nagano prefecture after ordering the restriction of distribution is attached as attachment 2
2. The list of Instructions on the restriction of distribution and/or consumption of food concerned in accordance with the Act on Special Measures Concerning Nuclear Emergency Preparedness is attached as reference.

From Director-General of the Nuclear Emergency Response Headquarters
To Governor of Nagano Prefecture,

Recognizing the accident occurred at the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant operated by TEPCO Co. Ltd, the following order shall take place, based on Article 20.2 of the Act on Special Measures Concerning Nuclear Emergency Preparedness (Act No. 156, 1999):

1. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Wild mushrooms collected in Karuizawa-machi and Miyota-machi for the time being.
