To Press and those who may concern,

Cancellation of Instruction to restrict distribution based on the Act on Special Measures Concerning Nuclear Emergency Preparedness, direction of Director-General of the Nuclear Emergency Response Headquarters

Today, based on the results of inspections conducted until yesterday, the Nuclear Emergency Response Headquarters has cancelled its Instruction of restriction of distribution and consumption of Governors of Fukushima and Miyagi as follows:

- (1) Matsutake(wild mushroom) produced in Fukushima prefecture (limiting to municipalities where Instruction of restriction of distribution and consumption are ordered) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture (※) .
- (2) Cultivated Ostrich fern produced in Nihonmatsu-city and Otama-village, Fukushima prefecture.
- (3) Matsutake(wild mushroom) produced in Kesennuma-city Miyagi prefecture which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Miyagi prefecture (※) .
- (※) Result of screening analysis by non-destructive equipment, matsutake(wild mushroom) which is lower than screening level is available for distribution and consumption.

1. With regard to Fukushima prefecture, the restriction of distribution and consumption of matsutake(wild mushroom) produced in Fukushima prefecture (limiting to municipalities where Instruction of restriction of distribution and consumption are ordered) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture and cultivated Ostrich fern produced in Nihonmatsu-city and Otama-village is cancelled today.

- (2) The application of Fukushima is attached as attachment 2.

2. With regard to Miyagi prefecture, the restriction of distribution of matsutake(wild mushroom) produced in Miyagi prefecture which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Miyagi prefecture is cancelled today.

(4) The application of Miyagi is attached as attachment 4.

From Director-General of the Nuclear Emergency Response Headquarters
To Governor of Fukushima Prefecture,

The Instruction to the Prefecture on August 24, 2021 based on the Article 20.2 of the Act on Special Measures Concerning Nuclear Emergency Preparedness (Act No. 156, 1999) shall be changed as follows.

1. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities, food business operators concerned and residents not to consume and distribute any non-head type leafy vegetables produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Tomioka-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Okuma-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013), Namie-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Katsurao-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on June 15, 2012), for the time being.
2. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities, food business operators concerned and residents not to consume and distribute any head type leafy vegetables produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Tomioka-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Okuma-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013), Namie-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Katsurao-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on June 15, 2012), for the time being.
3. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities, food business operators concerned and residents not to consume and distribute any flowerhead brassicas produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Tomioka-town, (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) Okuma-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013), Namie-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Katsurao-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on June 15, 2012), for the time being.
4. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Turnips produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Tomioka-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Okuma-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to “Restricted area”

designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013), Namie-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Katsurao-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on June 15, 2012), for the time being.

5. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Japanese apricot (Ume) produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30 2012) for the time being.
6. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Yuzus produced in Fukushima-city and Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012) for the time being.
7. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Chestnuts produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012) for the time being.
8. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Kiwi fruits produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30 2012) for the time being.
9. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in Fukushima-city (limiting to former Fukushima-city and former Oguni-village area), Nihonmatsu-city (limiting to former Shibukawa-village area) and Date-city (limiting to former Sekimoto-village, former Hashirazawa-village, former Tominari-village, former Kakeda-town, former Oguni-village and former Tsukidate-town area) in 2011, for the time being.
10. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in areas subjected to restriction of distribution in advance in 2012 (including Koriyama-city (limiting to former Fukuyama-town), Sukagawa-city (limiting to former Nishifukuro-village), Miharu-town (limiting to former Sawaishi-village), Otama-village (limiting to former Tamanoi-village), Fukushima-city (limiting to former Mizuhara-village and Tatsugoyama-village), Iwaki-city (limiting to former Yamada-village) and Kawamata-town (limiting to former Iizaka-village), for the time being; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice produced in 2012, which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
11. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in areas preparing for resumption of rice farming and areas where all rice farming and shipment are managed by local governments in 2013; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
12. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30 2012), Kawamata-town (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on August 7 2013), Naraha-town, Tomioka-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7 2013), Okuma-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7 2013), Namie-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7 2013), Kawauchi-village (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on March 30 2012), Katsurao-village (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on

March 7 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on June 15 2012) in 2014; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.

13. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Kawamata-town (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on August 7, 2013), Naraha-town, Tomioka-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Okuma-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013), Namie-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Kawauchi-village (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Katsurao-village (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on June 15, 2012) in 2015; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
14. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Kawamata-town (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on August 7, 2013), Naraha-town, Tomioka-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Okuma-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013), Namie-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Kawauchi-village (limiting to “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on September 12, 2014), Katsurao-village (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on June 15, 2012) in 2016; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
15. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Kawamata-town (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on August 7, 2013), Tomioka-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Okuma-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013), Namie-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Kawauchi-village (limiting to “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on September 12, 2014), Katsurao-village (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to areas except

“Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on June 15, 2012) in 2017; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.

16. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in Kawamata-town (limiting to “Areas in which the residents are not permitted to live” and “Areas to which evacuation orders are ready to be lifted” designated by the Instruction on August 7, 2013), Tomioka-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Okuma-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013), Namie-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) in 2018; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
17. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in Okuma-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012) and Futaba-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013) in 2019; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
18. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in Okuma-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012(excluding areas such restriction on access was eased on March 5,2020)) and Futaba-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013) in 2020; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
19. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any rice produced in Okuma-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012 (excludes “the specified reconstruction and revitalization base area” certified on November 10, 2017)), Futaba-town (limiting to areas except “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013 (excludes “the specified reconstruction and revitalization base area” certified on September 15, 2017)), Katsurao-village (limiting to “the specified reconstruction and revitalization base area” certified on May 11, 2018) in 2021; provided, however, that this shall not apply to rice which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
20. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute raw milk produced in Minamisoma-city (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Tomioka-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Okuma-town, Futaba-town, Namie-town (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Katsurao-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to “Restricted area” designated by the Instruction on June 15, 2012) for the time being.
21. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities, food business operators concerned and residents not to consume any log-grown Shiitakes (outdoor cultivation) produced in Iitate-village for the time being.
22. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any log-grown Shiitakes (outdoor cultivation) produced in Fukushima-city, Nihonmatsu-city, Date-city, Motomiya-city, Soma-city, Minamisoma-city, Tamura-city (limiting to area within 20 km radius from the TEPCO’s Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant),

Kawamata-town, Namie-town, Futaba-town, Okuma-town, Tomioka-town, Naraha-town, Hirono-town, Iitate-village, Katsurao-village and Kawauchi-village (limiting to area within 20 km radius from the TEPCO's Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant) for the time being.

23. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any log-grown Shiitakes (indoor cultivation) produced in Date-city for the time being; provided, however, that this shall not apply to log-grown Shiitakes which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
24. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any log-grown Shiitakes (indoor cultivation) produced in Kawamata-town for the time being.
25. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any log-grown pholiota nameko (outdoor cultivation) produced in Soma-city and Iwaki-city for the time being.
26. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities, food business operators concerned and residents not to consume any wild mushrooms gathered in Minamisoma-city, Iwaki-city and Tanagura-town for the time being, however, that shall not apply to matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture.
27. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms produced in Fukushima-city, Nihonmatsu-city, Date-city, Motomiya-city, Koriyama-city, Sukagawa-city, Tamura-city, Shirakawa-city, Kitakata-city, Soma-city, Minamisoma-city, Iwaki-city, Kori-town, Kunimi-town, Kawamata-town, Kagamiishi-town, Ishikawa-town, Asakawa-town, Furudono-town, Miharu-town, Ono-town, Yabuki-town, Tanagura-town, Yamatsuri-town, Hanawa-town, Bandai-town, Inawashiro-town, Aizubange-town, Shimogo-town, Hirono-town, Naraha-town, Tomioka-town, Okuma-town, Futaba-town, Namie-town, Shinci-town, Otama-village, Tenei-village, Tamakawa-village, Hirata-village, Nishigo-village, Izumizaki-village, Nakajima-village, Samekawa-village, Kitashiobara-village, Kawauchi-village, Katsurao-village and Iitate-village for the time being, however, that shall not apply to matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture.
28. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms produced in Aizuwakamatsu-city for the time being, however, that shall not apply to late fall oyster mushroom, brick cap mushroom and matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture.
29. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms produced in Nishiaizu-town for the time being, however, that shall not apply to grifola frondosa (maitake), pholiota nameko, late fall oyster mushroom and matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture.
30. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms produced in Aizumisato-town for the time being, however, that shall not apply to pholiota nameko, late fall oyster mushroom and matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture.
31. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms produced in Tadami-town for the time being, however, that shall not apply to honey mushroom, bunaharitake, pholiota nameko, late fall oyster

mushroom, brick cap mushroom, grifola frondosa (maitake) and matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture.

32. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms produced in Yanaizu-town for the time being, however, that shall not apply to grifola frondosa (maitake) and matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture.
33. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms (excluding grifola frondosa (maitake)) produced in Mishima-town for the time being, however, that shall not apply to matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture.
34. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms (excluding late fall oyster mushroom (mukitake) and grifola frondosa (maitake)) produced in Showa-village for the time being, however, that shall not apply to matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Fukushima prefecture.
35. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Bamboo shoots produced in Fukushima-city, Nihonmatsu-city, Date-city, Motomiya-city, Koriyama-city, Sukagawa-city, Tamura-city, Shirakawa-city, Soma-city, Minamisoma-city, Iwaki-city, Kori-town, Kawamata-town, Miharu-town, Hirono-town, Naraha-town, Shinchi-town, Otama-village, Tenei-village, Nishigo-village, Kawauchi-village and Katsurao-village for the time being.
36. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Wasabi (limiting to field cultivation) produced in Date-city, however, that this shall not apply to Wasabi which is controlled under the management policy set by Fukushima prefecture.
37. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Wasabi (limiting to field cultivation) produced in Kawamata-town (limiting to Yamakiya area), for the time being.
38. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild Aralia cordata produced in Sukagawa-city, Soma-city, Hirono-town, Naraha-town, Kawauchi-town and Katsurao-village for the time being.
39. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild Uwabamisou produced in Sukagawa-city and Kunimi-town for the time being.
40. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Ostrich ferns produced in Fukushima-city, Date-city, Koriyama-city, Tamura-city, Soma-city, Kori-town, Kunimi-town, Kawamata-town, Miharu-town, Hirono-town, Naraha-town and Katsurao-village for the time being.
41. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Wild ostrich ferns produced in Nihonmatsu-city, Minamisoma-city and Otama-village for the time being.
42. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Koshiabura produced in Fukushima-city, Nihonmatsu-city, Date-city, Motomiya-city, Koriyama-city, Sukagawa-city, Tamura-city, Shirakawa-city, Aizuwakamatsu-city, Kitakata-city, Soma-city, Minamisoma-city, Iwaki-city, Kori-town, Kunimi-town, Kawamata-town, Kagamiishi-town, Ishikawa-town, Asakawa-town, Furudono-town, Miharu-town, Ono-town, Yabuki-town, Tanagura-town, Yamatsuri-town, Hanawa-town, Bandai-town, Inawashiro-town, Aizubange-town, Yanaizu-town, Mishima-town, Kanayama-town, Aizumisato-town, Shimogo-town,

Minamiaizu-town, Hirono-town, Shinchi-town, Otama-village, Tenei-village, Tamakawa-village, Hirata-village, Nishigo-village, Izumizaki-village, Nakajima-village, Samegawa-village, Kitashiobara-village, Showa-village, Kawauchi-village and Katsurao-village for the time being.

43. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Wild Koshiabura produced in Nishiaizu-town and Tadami-town for the time being.
44. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Japanese royal ferns produced in Nihonmatsu-city, Koriyama-city, Sukagawa-city, Tamura-city, Soma-city, Minamisoma-city, Iwaki-city, Kawamata-town, Naraha-town, Kawauchi-village and Katsurao-village for the time being.

46. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild Aralia sprout produced in Fukushima-city, Nihonmatsu-city, Date-city, Motomiya-city, Koriyama-city, Sukagawa-city, Tamura-city, Shirakawa-city, Soma-city, Minamisoma-city, Iwaki-city, Kori-town, Kawamata-town, Kagamiishi-town, Furudono-town, Hanawa-town, Inawashiro-town, Hirono-town, Shinchi-town, Otama-village, Kitashiobara-village, Nishigo-village, Izumizaki-village, Samegawa-village, Kawauchi-village and Katsurao-village for the time being.
47. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Giant butterbur produced in Katsurao-village for the time being.
48. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild Giant butterbur produced in Kori-town, Naraha-town and Tenei-village for the time being.
49. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild Japanese butterbur scape produced in Fukushima-city, Date-city, Motomiya-city, Soma-city, Minamisoma-city, Kori-town, Kunimi-town, Kawamata-town, Hirono-town, Naraha-town and Katsurao-village for the time being.
50. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Pteridium aquilinum produced in Minamisoma-city, Kawamata-town, Naraha-town, Samegawa-village and Katsurao-village for the time being.
51. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild Pteridium aquilinum produced in Fukushima-city, Nihonmatsu-city, Iwaki-city, Date-city and Hirono-town for the time being.
52. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute Black rockfish captured in Fukushima offshore, for the time being.
53. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Ayu (excluding farmed fish) captured in Mano River (including its branches) and Niida River (including its branches) in Fukushima prefecture for the time being.
54. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Chars (Iwana) (excluding farmed fish) captured in Abukuma River in Fukushima prefecture (limiting to lower reaches from Shinobu Dam and including its branches), for the time being.
55. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Japanese daces captured in Mano River (including its branches), for the time being.
56. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Japanese eel captured in Abukuma River in Fukushima prefecture (including its branches), for the time being.

57. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Common carps (excluding farmed fish) captured in Akimoto Lake, Onogawa Lake and Hibara Lake and rivers flowing into these lakes (including its branches) and Nagase River (limiting to upper reaches from junction with Sukawa River), for the time being.
58. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Crucian carps (excluding farmed fish) captured in Akimoto Lake and rivers flowing into the lakes (including its branches), Nagase River (limiting to upper reaches from junction with Sukawa River), Mano River (including its branches) and Abukuma River in Fukushima prefecture (limiting to lower reaches from Shinobu Dam and including its branches), for the time being.
59. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned and residents not to consume any Land-locked cherry salmons (excluding farmed fish) captured in Niida River (including its branches) for the time being.
60. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Land-locked cherry salmons (Yamame) (excluding farmed fish) captured in Inawashiro Lake and rivers flowing into the lakes (including its branches but excluding Sukawa River (including its branches)) and Nagase River (excluding upper reaches from the junction with Sukawa River), Ota River (including its branches), Niida River (including its branches), Nippashi River (limiting to upper reaches from Tokyo electric power company's Kanagawa power plant, but including its branches), Mano River (including its branches) and Abukuma River (including its branches) in Fukushima prefecture, for the time being.
61. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to move any Cattle (excluding under 12-month old) to outside of the prefecture nor ship to slaughterhouses for the time being, which is farmed in Minamisoma-city (limiting to "Restricted area" designated by the Instruction on March 30, 2012), Tomioka-town (limiting to "Restricted area" designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Okuma-town (limiting to "Restricted area" designated by the Instruction on November 30, 2012), Futaba-town (limiting to "Restricted area" designated by the Instruction on May 7, 2013), Namie-town (limiting to "Restricted area" designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013), Katsurao-village (limiting to "Restricted area" designated by the Instruction on March 7, 2013) and Iitate-village (limiting to "Restricted area" designated by the Instruction on June 15, 2012).
62. 64. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Spot-billed duck meat obtained after capturing in Fukushima prefecture for the time being.
65. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Green pheasant meat obtained after capturing in Fukushima prefecture for the time being.
66. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Bear meat obtained after capturing in Fukushima-city, Nihonmatsu-city, Date-city, Motomiya-city, Koriyama-city, Sukagawa-city, Tamura-city, Shirakawa-city,

68. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any copper pheasant meat obtained after capturing in Fukushima prefecture, for the time being.

Instruction

From Director-General of the Nuclear Emergency Response Headquarters
To Governor of Miyagi Prefecture,

The Instruction to the Prefecture on December 25, 2020 based on the Article 20.2 of the Act on Special Measures Concerning Nuclear Emergency Preparedness (Act No. 156, 1999) shall be changed as follows.

1. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute Log-grown shiitakes (outdoor cultivation) produced in Sendai-city, Ishinomaki-city, Kesennuma-city, Natori-city, Kakuda-city, Tome-city, Kurihara-city, Osaki-city, Shichikashuku-town, Murata-town, Kawasaki-town, Marumori-town, Taiwa-town, Ohira-village, Kami-town, Minamisanriku-town and Shikama-town for the time being, provided, however, that this shall not apply to Log-grown shiitakes (outdoor cultivation) which are controlled based on the management policy set by Miyagi prefecture.
2. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any log-grown shiitakes (outdoor cultivation) produced in Shiroishi-city, Higashimatsushima-city, Zao-town and Tomiya-city for the time being.
3. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms collected in Sendai-city, Kurihara-city, Osaki-city, Murata-town and Minamisanriku-town for the time being.
4. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild mushrooms collected in Kesennuma-city for the time being, however, that shall not apply to matsutake (wild mushroom) which are controlled under the policy for shipment and inspection set by Miyagi prefecture.
5. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any bamboo shoots produced in Kurihara-city (excluding former Tsukidate-town, former Shiwahime-town, former Takashimizu-town, former Semine-town, former Wakayanagi-town and former Ichihasama-town) and Marumori-town (excluding former Koya-village, former Marumori-town, former Kosai-village, former Hippo-village and former Ouchi-village) for the time being.
6. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Koshiabura produced in Kesennuma-city, Tome-city, Kurihara-city, Osaki-city, Shichikashuku-town, Taiwa-town and Minamisanriku-town for the time being.
7. Restrictive requirements shall apply to head of municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Japanese royal fern produced in Kesennuma-city, and Osaki-city, for the time being
8. Restrictive requirements shall apply to head of municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild Japanese royal fern produced in Marumori-town, for the time being.
9. Restrictive requirements shall apply to head of municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild Aralia sprout produced in Kurihara-city and Osaki-city, for

the time being.

10. Restrictive requirement shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any wild *Pteridium aquilinum* produced in Osaki-city and Kami-town, for the time being.
11. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Char(Iwana)(excluding farmed fish) captured in Ichihasama river (limiting upper reaches from Hanayama dam and including its branches), Eai river (limiting upper reaches from Naruko dam and including its branches), Goishi river (limiting upper reaches from Kamafusa dam and including its branches), Sanhasama river (limiting upper reaches from Kurikoma dam and including its branches), Natori river (limiting upper reaches from Akiuotaki waterfall and including its branches), Nihasama river (limiting upper reaches from Aratozawa dam and including its branches), Hirose river (including its branches) and Matsukawa river (including its branches but excluding Nigorikawa river and its branches and upper reaches from Sumikawa No.4 dam), for the time being.
12. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Japanese dace captured in Abukuma river in Miyagi prefecture (including its branches but excluding upper reaches from Shichigashuku dam), and Kitakami river in Miyagi prefecture (including its branches), for the time being.
13. Restrictive requirements shall apply to food business operators concerned not to distribute any Land-locked cherry salmon(Yamame)(excluding farmed fish) captured in Shiroishi river in Miyagi prefecture (including its branches but excluding upper reaches from Shichigashuku dam), for the time being.
14. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Boar meat obtained after capturing in Miyagi prefecture, for the time being.
15. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Bear meat obtained after capturing in Miyagi prefecture, for the time being
16. Restrictive requirements shall apply to heads of relevant municipalities and food business operators concerned not to distribute any Sika deer meat obtained after capturing in Miyagi prefecture, for the time being, however, that shall not apply to Sika deer meat which are managed based on shipment and inspection policy set by Miyagi prefecture.
