Medical check-up categories indicating values to be increased or decreased in relation to radiation exposure doses in the Adult Health Study conducted by the Radiation Effects Research Foundation

- Height and weight: Reduction was seen in those who were exposed during their childhood or fetal period (These results are not applicable to the workers)
- Blood pressure: Elevated
- Leukocyte count: Increased in those who were exposed to higher doses of radiation (2 Gy or higher)
- Hemoglobin: Decreased
- Renal function: Decreased (eGFR values decreased)
- Total cholesterol: Increased (particularly in women)
- HBs antigen: Increased
- CRP: Increased
- Rheumatoid factor: Increased

(Note) These results are associated with radiation exposure doses, but that does not necessarily mean that they were induced by radiation.
