Overview of the Expert Committee for the Testing of Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy

Enacted: October 17, 2001 Revised: November 1, 2001

(Objective)

Article 1 To provide guidance and advice concerning tests of Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy, and contribute to safety measures for meat concerning Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy, Director-General of the Department of Food Safety, Pharmaceutical and Food Safety Bureau, organizes the Expert Committee for the Testing of Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (hereinafter referred to as "Expert Committee").

(Discussion)

- Article 2 The Expert Committee shall discuss:
 - 1) Technical guidance and advice concerning tests of Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy;
 - 2) Evaluation of test results based on "Implementation Guideline for Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy Tests"; and
 - 3) Other necessary issues concerning tests of Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy.

(Organization)

- Article 3 The Expert Committee shall be consisted of members listed in a separate table.
 - 2 Term of the member experts shall be until the discussion concludes.
 - 3 The Expert Committee shall be headed by Chairman and Deputy Chairman.
 - 4 Chairman shall be selected by mutual voting of the member experts. Deputy Chairman shall be assigned by Chairman from the other members of the Expert Committee.
 - 5 Chairman represents the Expert Committee, and chairs the Committee affairs.
 - 6 Deputy Chairman supports Chairman, and surrogates him in case of accident.

(Committee session)

- Article 4 Sessions of the Expert Committee shall be called by Chairman.
 - 2 The Expert Committee sessions shall not be opened without a turnout of majority of member experts. In case of emergency, however, members may be regarded as present, by submitting their opinions in prior reports, etc.
 - 3 The Expert Committee sessions shall be opened to the public. However, sessions may be held behind closed doors if so determined by the Expert Committee.
 - 4 Minutes of the Expert Committee sessions shall be disclosed.
 - 5 The Expert Committee may ask for attendance of related parties, and listen to their opinions, if they regard it necessary.

(General affairs)

Article 5 General affairs of the Expert Committee shall be handled by the Inspection and Safety Division, Department of Food Safety, Pharmaceutical and Food Safety Bureau.

(Miscellanea)

Article 6 Other issues necessary for the operation of the Expert Committee, in addition to the provisions of this overview, shall be determined by Chairman.
