Students, non-working wives and those who have studied abroad need special attention on the deemed period of the pension program.

The "deemed period (period subject to aggregation)" is included in the period entitled for pension benefit, such as the old age pension, but not reflected in the amount of benefit. More concretely, the deemed period includes: (1) the period before March 1986 when the enrollees who could have joined the national pension plan did not do so; (2) the period before March 1991 when the beneficiaries did not join the national pension plan because of being a student; and (3) the period from and after April 1961 when the participants had been abroad.
