IHP+ is transforming into the International Health Partnership for UHC 2030

We will become a movement for progress towards universal health coverage, inviting new partners to join.

In September 2015 the world moved from focusing on the Millennium Development Goals to the universal and more ambitious Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). SDG 3 demonstrates a renewed global commitment to health, underpinned by target 3.8 for Universal Health Coverage (UHC). This presents an opportunity to promote a comprehensive and coherent approach to strengthening health systems for progress across all health targets.

International Health Partnership for UHC 2030

The overall aim of the International Health Partnership for UHC 2030 is to support a movement for accelerated, equitable and sustainable progress towards universal health coverage as well as the other health targets in the SDGs, including global security and equity. The partnership builds on a transformed IHP+, making it fit for purpose in the new SDG era.

Key Objectives:

- Coordinate health systems strengthening efforts by creating synergies between related technical networks and partnerships
- Build political momentum around a shared global vision of health systems strengthening for universal health coverage and advocate for sufficient, appropriate and well-coordinated investments in universal health coverage
- Facilitate accountability for progress towards HSS, UHC and SDG3
- Promote coordination in countries receiving external assistance through adherence to IHP+ principles and behaviours

International Health Partnership for UHC 2030 at work:

- Provide a platform for multi-stakeholder and multi-sectoral engagement
- Establish principles for coordination on health systems strengthening and universal health coverage with targets for partners to meet
- Monitor progress, enhance accountability and build political momentum
- Share knowledge and information to equip partners with tools to improve coordination, advocacy and accountability for universal health coverage
