Guidelines on construction of core indicators

目的：この書類の主な目的は、国の AIDS 対策に関わっている人に、その国の対策の効果を測る重要な指標(core indicators)に基づく情報を、提供する事である。このガイドラインは、国が行っている活動のプロセスの一貫性と透明性を確保することに寄与する。また、この情報は UNAIDS が使い、UNGASS の活動報告として地域及び全世界の活動プロセス報告に用いられる。

国はこの重要な指標(core indicators)を、現在、実施しているモニタリング・評価活動に統合する事が強く勧められる。
