今般、我が国にない動物由来感染症(動物から人が感染する病気)であるペストの国内への侵入防止のため、平成15年3月1日以降、プレーリードッグ(げっ歯目リス科)の我が国への輸入を禁止いたします(「感染症の予防及び感染症の患者に対する医療に関する法律施行令の一部を改正する政令」(平成15年2月5日政令第35号の施行に伴うもの))。

つきましては、本件について御了知いただくとともに、関係機関、特に貴国国内の輸出業者への周知等を含め、プレーリードッグが日本へ輸出されることのないよう、特段のご協力をお願いいたします。

なお、同日以降、万が一、日本へプレーリードッグが到着した場合には、返送、殺処分等 の措置が講じられることを申し添えます。

Subject: The amendment of the government ordinance based on "the Law Concerning the Prevention of Infections and Medical Care for Patients of Infections" (Announcement of and request for cooperation on import ban of prairie dogs)

Dear Dr. DeHaven,

This letter is to advise you that importation of prairie dogs [Order: Rodentia (Rodents)/Family: Sciuridae (Squirrels) / Genus: Prairie Dogs] into Japan shall be banned on March 1 2003, when the amendment (promulgated in February 5) to the government ordinance based on "the Law Concerning Prevention of Infections and Medical Care for Patients of Infections" is enacted. This amendment is for the purpose of keeping plague, an infectious disease which animals can be a source of human infection, from entering into our territory; the disease is not currently reported in Japan and we have acknowledged that import of prairie dogs has a risk of bringing in this disease.

We would like you to note the above and help your members and related institutions become aware of this amendment. Especially, we ask for your cooperation to make sure that exporters in your country do not send prairie dogs to Japan.

Lastly, please note that the said animals, arriving in Japan from March 1 2003, shall be under the order of reshipment or destruction in accordance with the above amendment.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
