Zika Virus disease transmission persists

please consult a quarantine officer.**

* If you exhibit symptoms after entering Japan, please seek
guidance at your local health center.



Avoid being bitten by mosquitoes

To prevent the spread of the Zika Virus in Japan, take measures to avoid
being bitten by mosquitoes for at least 2 weeks after coming to Japan, by
regularly applying bug repellent etc., **regardless if there are clinical
symptoms or not.**

The disease may be transmitted through sexual contact

use a condom if you engage in sex, or refrain from sex altogether for at
least 3 months for men and 2 months for women (or, if your partner is
pregnant, during her pregnancy) after your return to Japan, **regardless if
there are clinical symptoms or not.**
