I. OVERVIEW

- 6.2 million PWDs (6.5% of the population), in which there are about 1 million people with autism;
 - 1% of all children born is children with autism
 - Low educational attainment
- + Many are illiterate;
- + Most of the households with PWD are poor and near poor;

1. Mobility disability

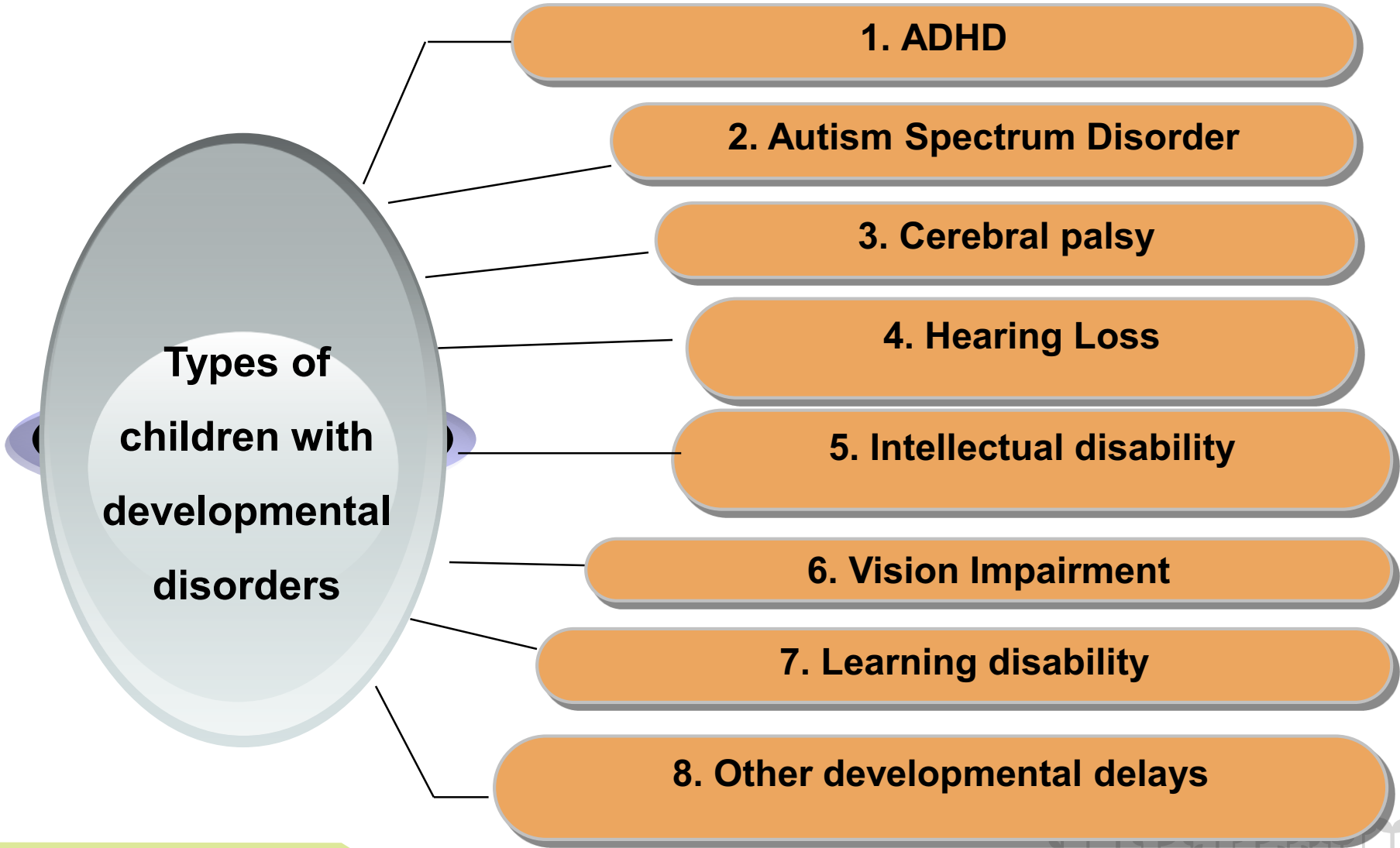

- Law on PWDs 2010
- Decree No. 28/2012 / ND-CP of the Government detailing and guiding a number of articles of the law on the disabled
- Decree No. 136/2013 / ND-CP on provides for social support policies for social protection subjects
- Decree No. 103/2017 / ND-CP regulating the establishment, organization, operation, dissolution and management of social assistance institutions;
- Circular 01/2019 / TT-LĐTBXH on the determination of disability degree implemented by the Disability Degree Determination Council



State Policies on PWDs in general



- Prevention and reduction of birth defects, disabilities caused by injury, illness and other risks leading to disabilities.
- Social Protection;
- Health care
- Education, vocational training, employment
- Culture, sports, entertainment,
- Access to public facilities
- Access to information technology
- Support in access and use transportations;





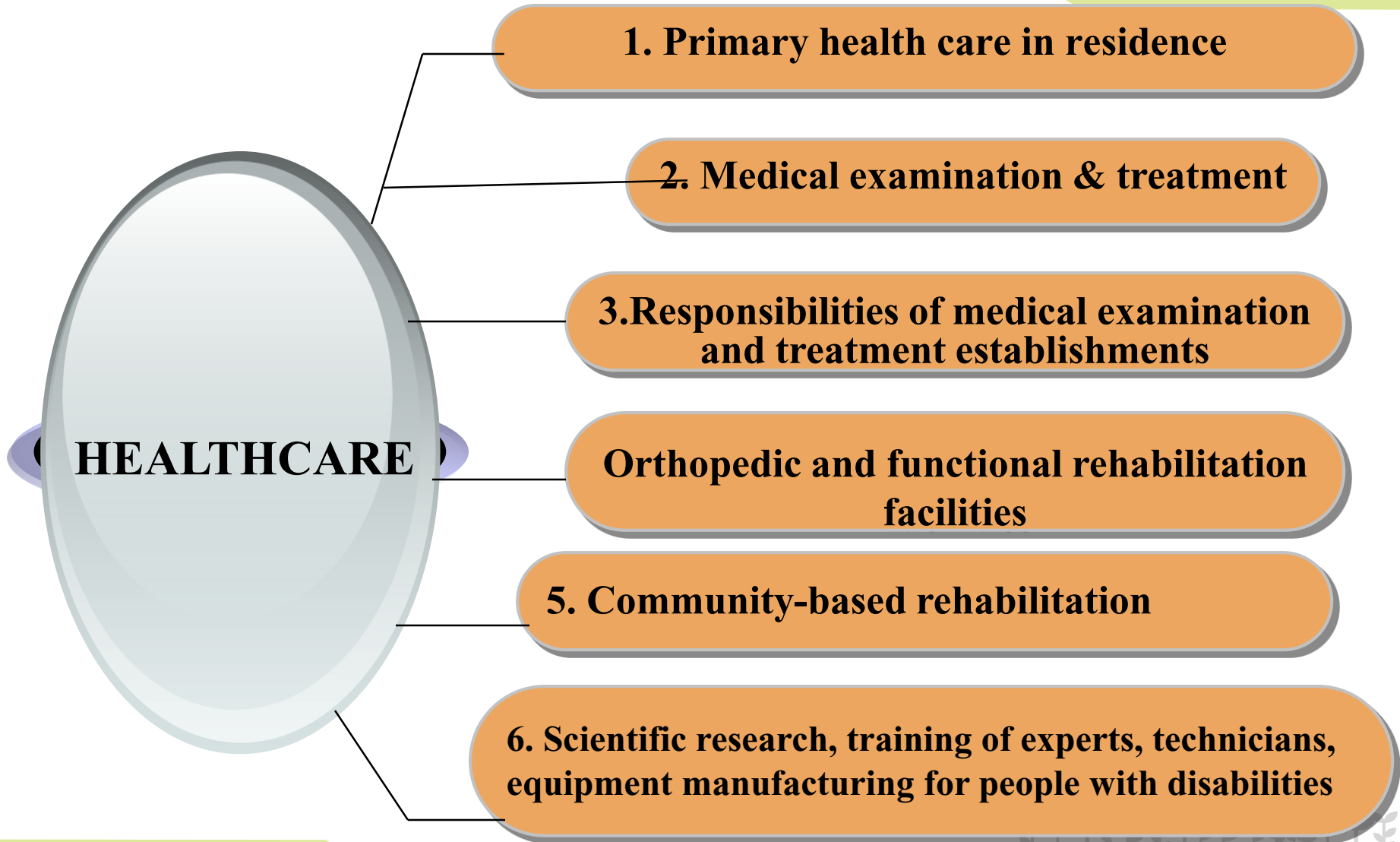
RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

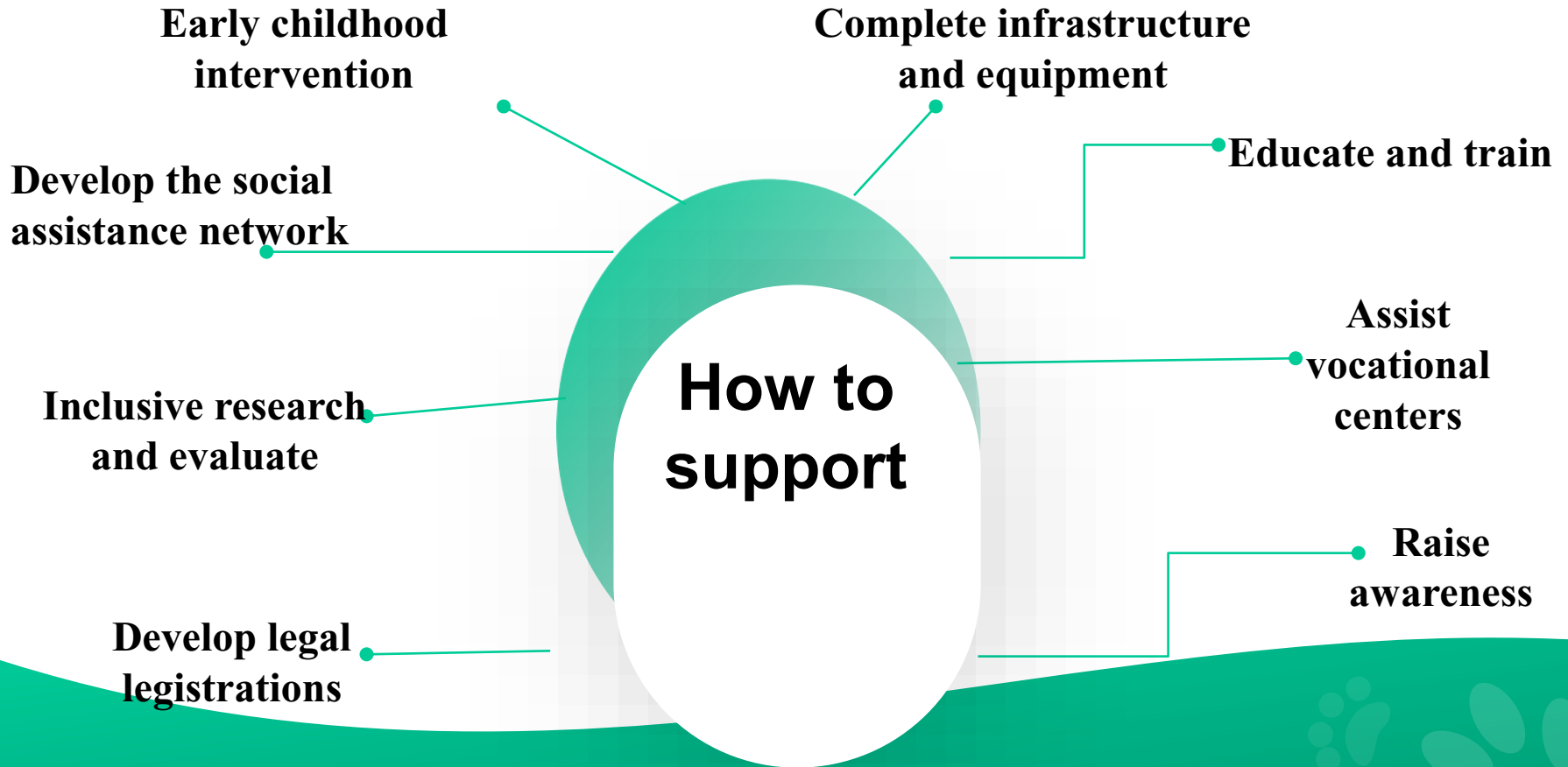

Represent the interests of persons with autism by promoting their rights and improving their access to appropriate support services.

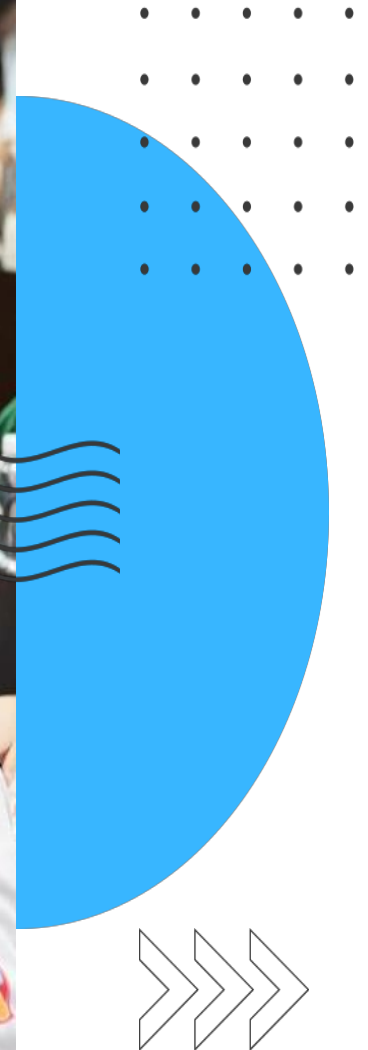

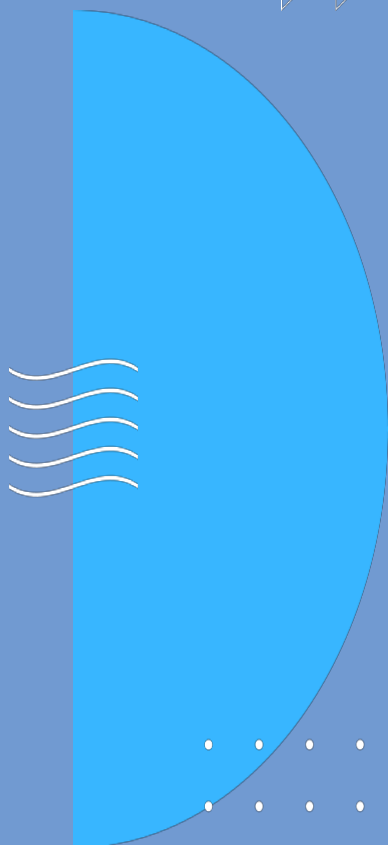
