The life expectancy in Myanmar

- 2023 - the life expectancy was 66.89 years.
- 2024 – the Life expectancy was 68.2 years.
- 2025 suggest it may be around 68.14 years.

66.89 years (2023)



Residential Care

- Myanmar has operated **elder care homes for over 100 years** for older people without family support.
DSW authorizes, provides technical assistance, and offers financial support to homes established by NGOs, private donors, and organizations (both local and international).






Day Care Centers for the Aged



- The **first free state-run day care center** for older persons was opened in **Yangon in November 2013** to reduce social isolation and promote active ageing.
It serves people **aged 70+**, without chronic illness, and socially isolated. Each participant receives **MMK 1,500 per day** from the state budget.
- Care services include:
 - **Physical care:** hygiene, mobility support, medical checkups, nutrition, and exercise.
 - **Mental/social care:** counseling, reading, recreation, cultural events, and interaction with children and community members.





Caregiver Training:

- Since **2015**, caregiver training programs have been conducted to equip people with elderly care skills, support family caregivers, and create employment opportunities.
17 training rounds have been held so far.

Social welfare programs



- Department of Social Welfare under the Ministry of Social Welfare, Relief and Resettlement implements seven social welfare programs supporting to ensure **income security** and access to health services.
- **all pension** began in **FY 2017–2018** for people **aged 90+**, providing **MMK 10,000 per month** (paid quarterly).
In **FY 2018–2019**, the eligible age was **reduced to 85+**.
In **FY 2025–2026**, there are **121,622 beneficiaries**, receiving a total of **MMK 7,216.94 million**





Financial Assistance for Vulnerable Groups:

- Emergency cash assistance of **MMK 30,000 per person** is provided to:
 - **FY 2023–2024:** 7,080 people (MMK 212.4 million)
 - **FY 2024–2025:** 14,720 people (MMK 441.6 million)
 - **FY 2025–2026 (to Oct):** 2,093 people (MMK 62.81 million)





Future Plan

- ASEAN Plus Three (10+3) Research Project on Active Ageing Policies
- National Strategic Planning for elderly care in Myanmar
- Partnerships with NGOs and international bodies (e.g., UNFPA, HelpAge International)


