

Challenges

- 1. There are 1.085 Social Institution in Indonesia that participates in providing services for elderly that still need development in terms of program and working area.
- 2. Social worker actively participates in case responses including in emergency, nevertheless they cannot work alone. They still need support to work inclusively from the community and private sector.


■What we want to share at this meeting

- 1. Indonesia, through MoSA has been attempting to improve the standard and qualification of social institution in order to be accredited. One of the requirements for the institution to be considered qualified is to hire professional social worker.
- 2. To provide inclusive services for elderly, Indonesia delivered Presidential Decree No. 88 year 2021 on the National Strategy of Elderly where the implementation is crosscutting.
- 3. Since 2020, MoSA has been establishing Integrated and Inclusive Social Rehabilitation Assistances which focus on providing basic needs, psychosocial support, and empowerment for children, elderly, persons with disabilities, and other vulnerable group, namely ATENSI.
