What is an elderly person in Myanamr:

Elderly person means all Myanmar citizens who are 60 years of age and above. (Enacted Elderly People Law in 2016)

- Myanmar has implemented Social Welfare System accordance with
- 1) the Action Plan to Implement the ASEAN Declaration on Strengthening Social Protection,
- 2) Regional Plan of Action on Implementing Kuala Lumpur Declaration on Ageing: Empowering Older Persons and ASEAN Social Protection Results Framework, Myanmar has implemented Social Welfare System.

- In Elderly People Law(2016), in order to find the appropriate jobs for the elderly people who have capability and willingness to work, in coordination with the respective Union Ministries and Companies, Myanmar Elderly People Committee shall:
 - (1) arrange part-time job opportunities and jobs capable of doing by elderly people for them,
 - (2) arrange to get loans to do their livelihoods,
 - (3) provide vocational and professional training for elderly people,
- (4) take measures for appropriate tax reduction for the employers who give job opportunities to elderly people.
