




The airline industry looks like a very glamorous job.



Occurrences of Industrial Accidents




1	Reaction to motion/Improper motion	99 cases
2	Tripping	28 cases
3	Traffic accidents (on roads)	24 cases
4	Falls from height	19 cases
5	Collision	17 cases

The airline industry is responsible for the customers' lives. Following the rules will protect your body, as well as the lives of customers.




In order to protect those lives with everything you have, you need to be healthy first, don't you think?


If we become seriously injured, our family will be worried, and it will affect our income...

What other examples of accidents are there?





Coming through!







1 | Follow traffic rules

4 | Be careful of heatstroke




