and wearing masks.

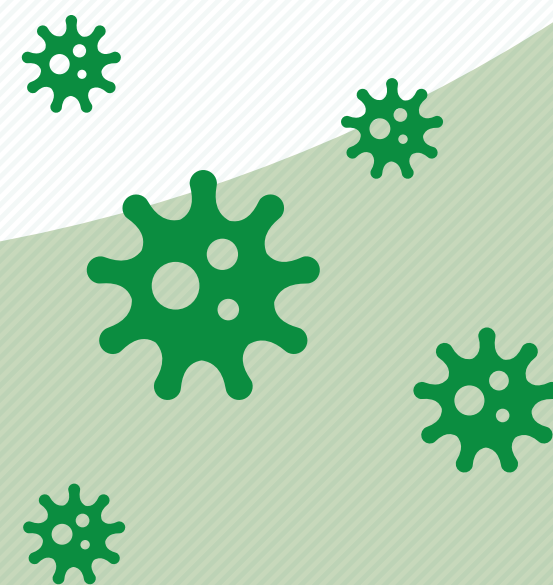
