## • Re: Comparison with the result of 2016 Hospital Report

The 2017 Static Survey of Medical Institutions reports that the number of professionals was unknown in 117 hospitals or around 1.4% of total 8,412 hospitals. (These hospitals are made up of those with numbers of professionals unknown for all types of professions and those with numbers of nurses and assistant nurses unknown among types of professionals that are supposed to be assigned according to the personnel allocation standard.) The reference table is provided for valid comparison under the same conditions which were created by excluding, from the result of the 2016 Hospital Report, hospitals with the number of professionals unknown in the 2017 Static Survey of Medical Institutions (or excluding numbers of nurses and assistant nurses in case of hospitals with numbers of nurses and assistant nurses unknown in the 2017 Survey).
