

## 2 Rates of Estimated Patients (per day, per 100,000 population)

The rates of estimated patients (per 100,000 population) in Nationwide (Except for Ishinomaki medical area and Kesenuma medical area of Miyagi prefecture, and Fukushima prefecture) are 1,068 in “inpatients” and 5,784 in “outpatients”.

### (1) Rates of estimated patient (per day, per 100,000 population) by sex and age group

The rate of estimated patients (per day) by sex is 1,005 “male” and 1,129 “female” in inpatients, and 5,014 “male” and 6,514 “female” in outpatients. By age group, in inpatients, age groups of “10 to 14 years old” have the lowest rates at 98, respectively, and the rates increase as the age group becomes older. In outpatients, age group of “15 to 19 years old” is the lowest at 2,017 and “80 to 84” is the highest at 13,457. (Table 7)

**(2) Rates of estimated patients (per day, per 100,000 population) by disease and injury**

The rates of estimated patients by classification of diseases are from the highest in inpatient, “V Mental and behavioural disorders” (225), “IX Diseases of the circulatory system” (200), and “II Neoplasms” (120). Classification of diseases from the highest in outpatients are “XI Diseases of the digestive system”(1,036), “XIII Diseases of the musculoskeletal system and connective tissue”(798), and “IX Diseases of the circulatory system”(755). 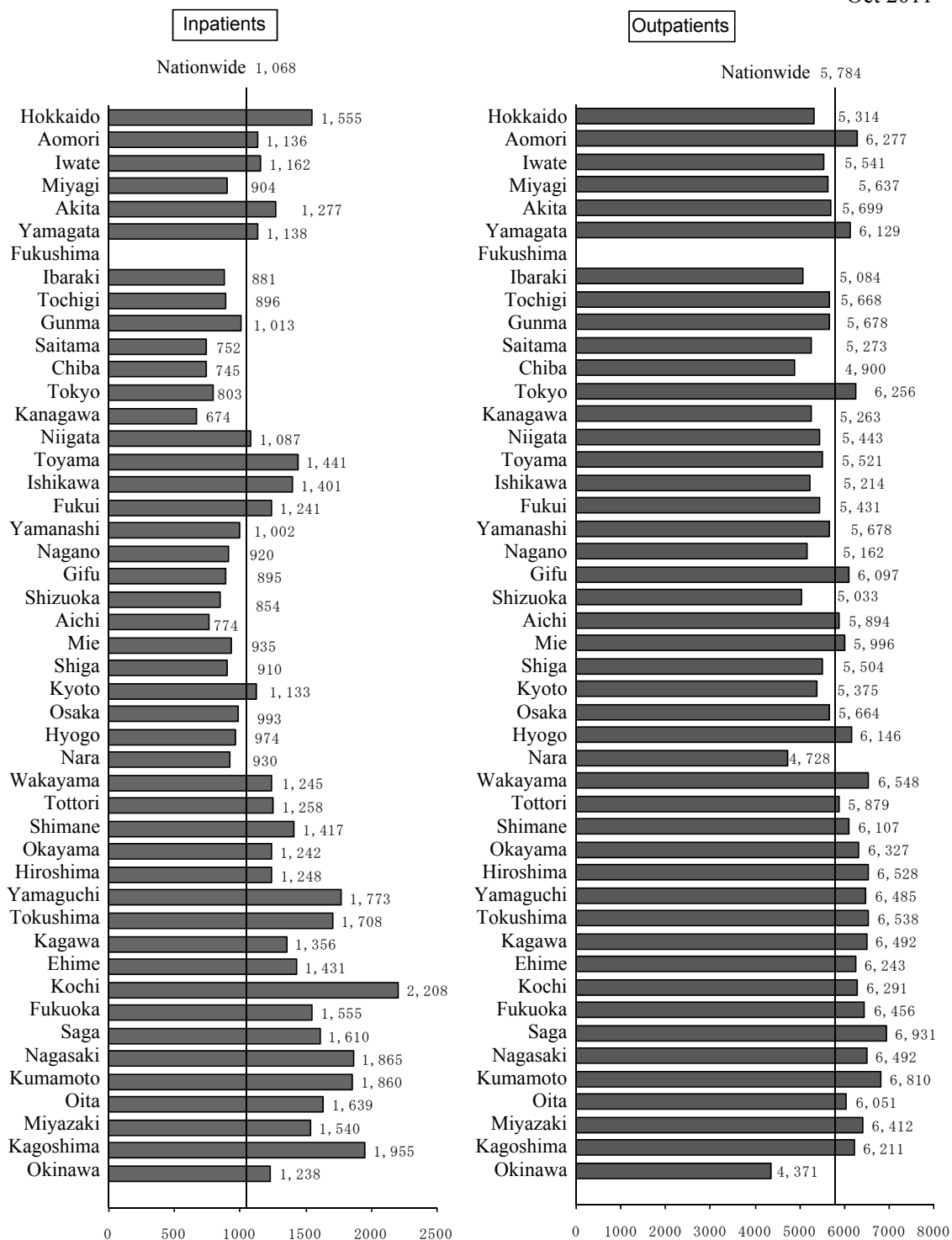
### (3) Rates of estimated patients (per day, per 100,000 population) by prefecture

In the rates of estimated patients by prefecture (place of residence of patient) among inpatients, the prefecture with the highest rate is “Kochi” at 2,208 then “Kagoshima” at 1,955 and “Nagasaki” at 1,865 follow. The lowest prefecture is “Kanagawa” with 674, and then “Chiba” with 745 and “Saitama” with 752 follow.

Among outpatients, the highest prefecture is “Saga” at 6,931 then “Kumamoto” with 6,810 and “Wakayama” with 6,548 follow. The lowest prefecture is “Okinawa” at 4,371, then “Nara” with 4,728 and “Chiba” with 4,900 follow (Figure 2).
