## 4 Estimated Number of Patients Receiving Medical Treatment for Selected Diseases

Estimated numbers of patients nationwide (Except for the Ishinomaki medical area and Kesennuma medical area of the Miyagi prefecture and the Fukushima prefecture) receiving medical treatment for selected diseases are 1,526 thousand for "Malignant neoplasms", 2,700 thousand for "Diabetes mellitus", 1,886 thousand for "Disorders of lipoprotein metabolism", 9,067 thousand for "Hypertensive diseases", 1,612 thousand for "Heart diseases (excluding hypertensive)", 1,235 thousand for "Cerebrovascular diseases" (Table 11).

\*) Definition of estimated number of patients receiving medical treatment (estimated number by diseases and injuries)

Estimated number of patients receiving medical treatment is the number of individuals who continuously receiving medical treatment (including those who did not receive medical treatment at medical institutions on the dates of this survey) calculated by the following formula.

Estimated number of patients receiving medical treatment = Estimated number of inpatients + Estimated number of first visit outpatients + Estimated number of following visit outpatients  $\times$  Average interval since last visit  $\times$  Adjustment factor (6/7)
