

## 2 Rates of Estimated Patients (per day, per 100,000 population )

The rates of estimated patients (per 100,000 population) in Nationwide are 1,038 in “inpatients” and 5,696 in “outpatients”.

### (1) Rates of estimated patient (per day, per 100,000 population ) by sex and age group

The rate of estimated patients (per day) by sex is 977 “male” and 1,095 “female” in inpatients, and 5,066 “male” and 6,292 “female” in outpatients. By age group, 2,840 is age groups of “65 years of age and older” and 4,205 is age groups of “75 years of age and older” in inpatient, and 10,637 is age groups of “65 years of age and older” and 11,906 is age groups of “75 years of age and older” in outpatients (Table 4).

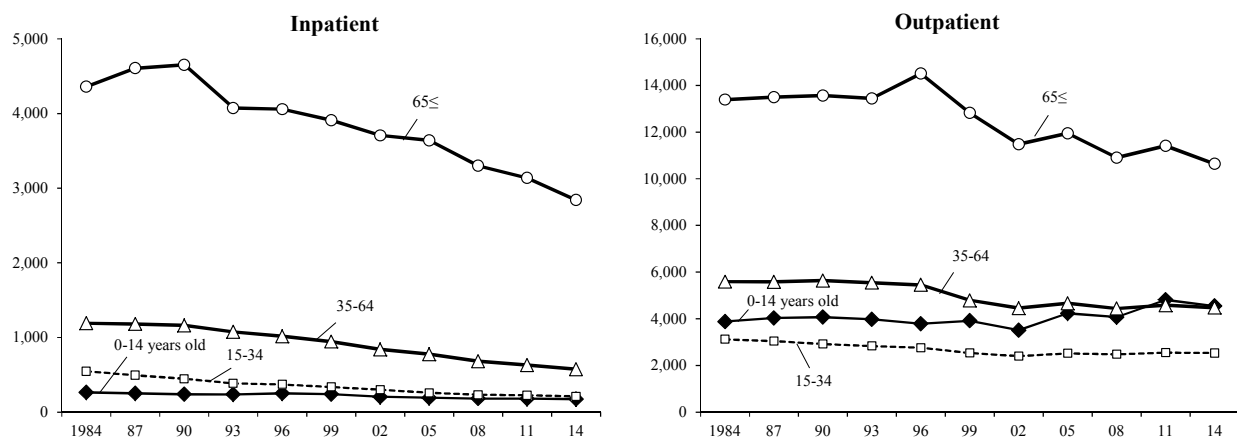

By age group, the rate of estimated patients (per 100,000 population) is the highest in "65 years old or older" for both inpatient and outpatient. However the rate is showing a downward trend. (Figure 5).

**(2) Rates of estimated patients (per day, per 100,000 population) by Classification of Diseases**

The rates of estimated patients by classification of diseases are from the highest in inpatient, “V Mental and behavioural disorders” (209), “IX Diseases of the circulatory system” (189), and “II Neoplasms” (114).

Classifications of diseases from the highest in outpatients are “XI Diseases of the digestive system” (1,031), “IX Diseases of the circulatory system” (734), and “XIII Diseases of the musculoskeletal system and connective tissue” (691). (Table 5, Statistics Table 5)

### (3) Rates of estimated patients (per day, per 100,000 population) by prefecture

In the rates of estimated patients by prefecture (place of residence of patient) among inpatients, the prefecture with the highest rate is “Kochi” at 2,215 then “Kagoshima” at 1,885 and “Nagasaki” at 1,812 follow. The lowest prefecture is “Kanagawa” with 683, and then “Saitama” with 723 and “Chiba” with 745 follow.

Among outpatients, the highest prefecture is “Saga” at 6,850 then “Wakayama” with 6,570 and “Kumamoto” with 6,550 follow. The lowest prefecture is “Okinawa” at 4,317, then “Chiba” with 4,901 and “Ishikawa” with 4,921 follow (Figure 6).
