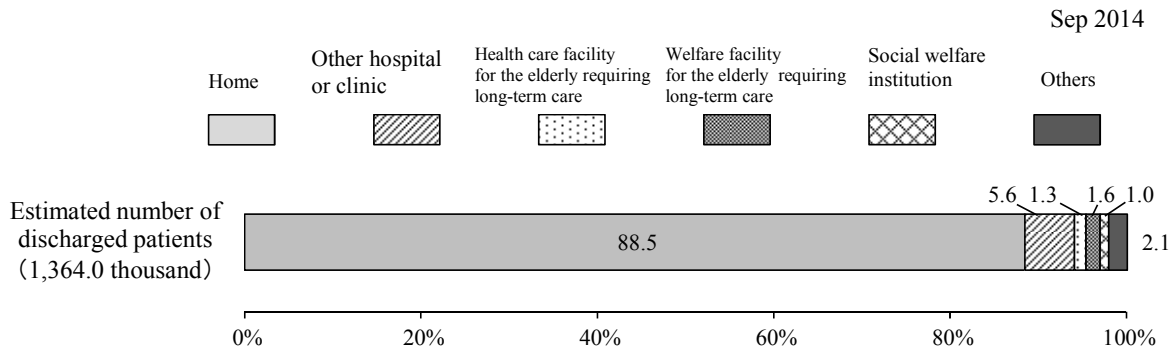


4 Location of Patients before Admission and after Discharge

For the location of patients before admission, 88.5% out of the total estimated number of discharged patients (1346.0 thousand) lived at “Home”. (Figure 10)

For the destination of patients after discharge, 84.0% was discharged to “Home”. (Figure 11)

Figure10 Percentage distribution of estimated number of discharged patients by location of patients before admission

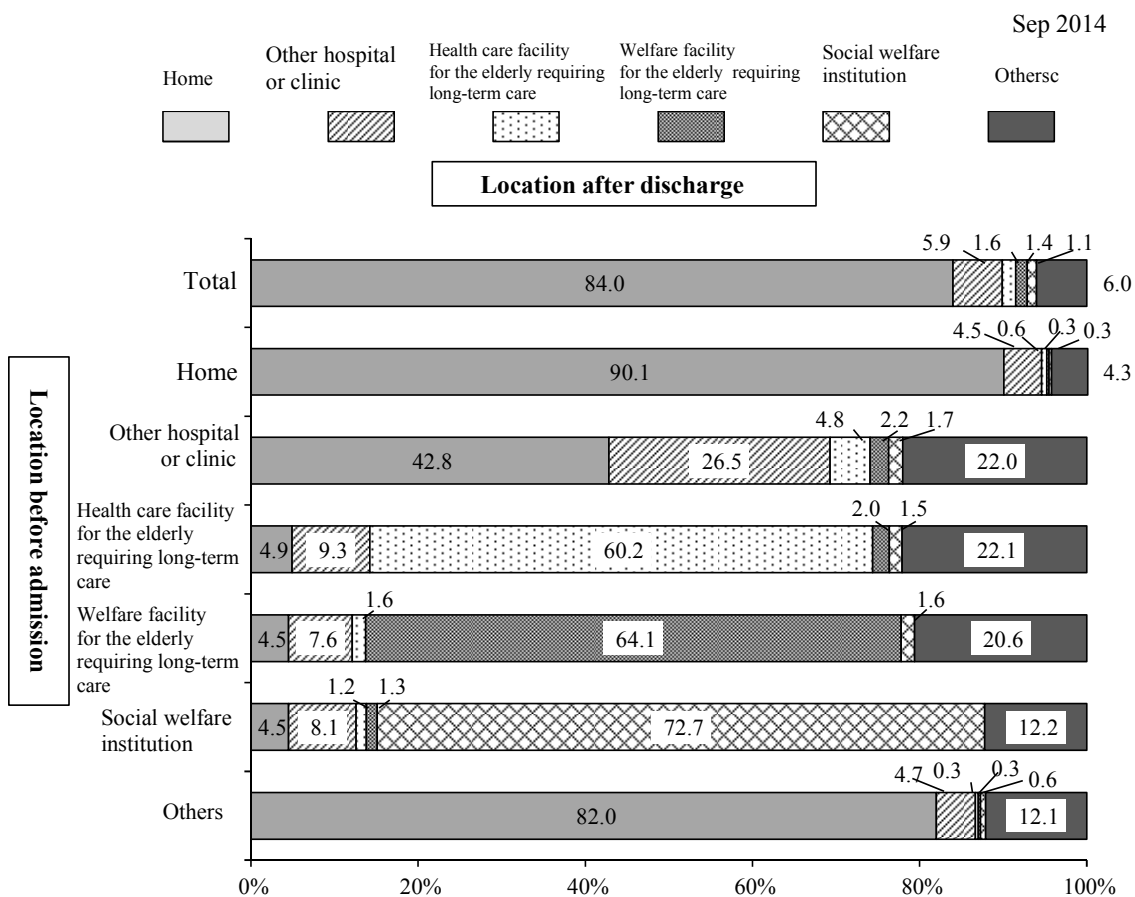


Note:1) Subjects of the survey were patients discharged during the period from 1st Sep to 30th Sep 2014.
