

“Survey of Social Welfare Institutions, 2011”

Outline of the Survey

1 Objective

To capture the number of social welfare institutions nationwide and the status of their users and employees, and to obtain basic data for the promotion of social welfare administration.

2 Coverage and Subject

Questionnaire for institutions: Covers social welfare institutions etc (82 types), and all of them (including those which are inactive) are the subject.

Questionnaire for social welfare service establishments for persons with disabilities etc: Covers social welfare service establishments for persons with disabilities (15 types) and consultation support establishments under the Services and Supports for Persons with Disabilities Act, and all of them (including those which are inactive) are the subject.

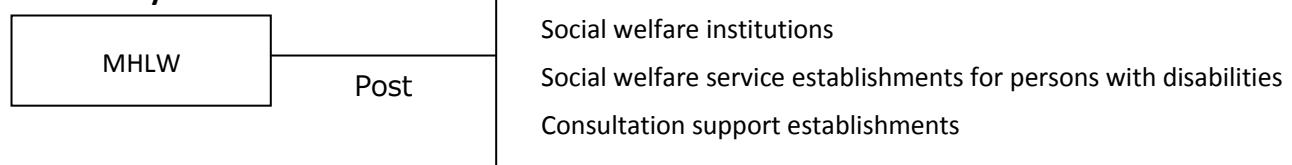

Questionnaire for institutions: Type of institution, name of institution, address, establishment entity and administrative body, capacity, status of users, status of employees, etc.

Questionnaire for social welfare service establishments for persons with disabilities etc: Type of establishment, name of establishment, address, administrative body, type of service, method of provision and status of provision, number of staffs, etc.

5 Survey Method and Route



* Regarding survey method and route:

Distribution and collection of questionnaires up to the 2008 survey was carried out by prefectures, designated cities and core cities for social welfare institutions, and by post from the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare for social welfare service establishments for persons with disabilities and consultation support establishments. From the 2009 survey, all questionnaires were delivered and collected by a private enterprise under a commission contract from the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare.

6 Tabulation of Results

Statistics and Information Department of the Minister's Secretariat at the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare conducted the tabulation.
