

“Mortality Statistics from Accidents”

“Mortality Statistics from Accidents” was prepared as a specified report of Vital Statistics, by performing a time-series analysis and a new multi-faceted analysis on the accidental deaths of Japanese persons which occurred in Japan, based on the Vital Statistics published each year.

This is the second issuance of “Mortality Statistics from Accidents,” and follows the first “Mortality Statistics from Accidents and Adverse Effects,” published in 1984.
