
Annual Trends in Marriages

(1) Number of marriages and marriage rates

To overview the trends in the number of marriages, the number reached 950,000 in 1948 during the "The first boom of marriage" that emerged right after World War II. From 1949, the number fell sharply and continuously decreased to 670,000 in 1951. Then, it turned to an increasing trend and stayed high for three years from 1970 to 1972. These years are called the "The second boom of marriage." The number reached 1.1 million in 1972. From 1973 to 1978, it fell sharply again. For the following several years, the number kept decreasing gradually until it turned to an increasing trend in 1988. It repeated a rise and fall after 1994, and since 2009, the number has generally shown a decreasing trend. The number of remarriages has stayed flat in recent years after having shown an increasing trend after 1979. (Figure 1)

(2) Number of marriages by marital status of partners

In terms of the annual trends in marriages by the marital status of partners, the number of "first marriages for both parties" shows a declining trend.

Meanwhile, the numbers of "remarriages for at least one party" showed an increasing trend until 2006 then turned to a declining trend. The numbers have stayed flat in recent years.

The ratio of "remarriages for at least one party" is in an increasing trend, exceeding 25% in 2005 and reaching 26.8% in 2015. (Table 1)

(3) Mean marriage age of grooms and brides and age difference of partners

In this section, we take a look at the annual trends of mean marriage ages by the marital status of partners. A continuous rising trend can be observed for both grooms and brides in all categories. The mean marriage ages of grooms and brides in the category of "first marriage for both parties" in 2015 are 30.7 and 29.0, respectively. The mean marriage ages in the category of "remarriages for both parties" in the same year are 46.5 for grooms and 42.7 for brides. The trend of the age difference of parties (groom's age – bride's age) shows little change in all categories in recent years.

As to the age difference between Japanese brides and grooms by their marital status, grooms have been younger than brides in terms of mean age difference in "marriages between unmarried grooms and remarrying brides" since 2000. (Table 2)

Note: Ages used for the calculation of mean marriage ages are ages of who filed their marriage papers and started to live together in a given year, and the ages are based on either the date of a marriage ceremony or the first day of the marriage life, whichever comes first.
