


Overview

The formal establishment of ERIA was agreed upon by all the leaders from 16 Member States at the 3rd East Asia Summit. 21 November 2007, Singapore



Promoting Active Ageing in Southeast Asia

- ERIA and OECD examined how population ageing affects ASEAN Member States, using national data from ASEAN and OECD countries.
- **Promoting Active Ageing**—where older adults engage confidently in work and community life—is increasingly crucial in ageing ASEAN societies.
- This report outlines **key challenges** and **policy responses**, and shows how active ageing **can benefit the economy** when effectively implemented.



Sustainable Financing for Integrated Care for Older Populations

FiSCO: Financial Sustainability of Integrated Care for Older Persons in Southeast Asia compared to East Asia

- **Assess the Situation** in SEA vs. East Asia
- **Develop Scenarios, Simulate and Forecast** the financial burden.
- Provide **Policy Recommendations**.
- Promote **Awareness**.
- **Capacity Building**.
- Establish **Collaborative Network & Platform**.

Rationale:


- Rapid Ageing in SEA; People live longer but not always healthier.
- Demand for care to older persons, particularly older women and caregivers, is rising due to declining fertility, shifting caregiving norms, smaller families, and changing living arrangements.
- Urgent need to strengthen financial security, risk protection, and financing systems to keep pace with rapid ageing.

Expected outcomes:

- Improved awareness.
- Enhanced access to care & health outcomes.
- Improved quality of care.
- Greater financial protection for older persons & families.
- Improved policies & governance; strengthened health financing systems.



Longitudinal Studies on Ageing and Health



- Coverage: the Philippines & Viet Nam
- Wave 1: 2018; Wave 2: 2023; Wave 3: under preparation.
- The first multiple-actor longitudinal study on ageing and health in both countries.
- Provide comprehensive information on **health, economic status**, and overall **well-beings** of over **6,000** people aged 60+
