- How to read the table entries: The number “184” in the box for the dose row of “1 < Dose \leq 2” and the period of “April – June 2014” column means that there were 184 workers who were engaged in the decontamination and related works, etc. during the period of April to June 2014 and whose doses were in the range of 1 mSv < Dose \leq 2 mSv.
- This table shows the data in the past one year based on the quaternary radiation exposure dose

distribution compiled as of 5 July 2015.

- This table shows the preliminary radiation exposure dose distribution of workers for decontamination and related works, etc. in the first quarter (January to March) of 2015 as well as the updated radiation exposure dose distribution including additional data provided after the last compilation date (30 March 2015) for the period from the second quarter to the fourth quarter of 2014.
