Re: Dispatch of Medical Doctors to the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant (Request)

At the TEPCO Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant, hereinafter referred to as “Fukushima Daiichi NPP,” many personnel are currently engaged in emergency works towards nuclear relief efforts.

In order to ensure the health care of personnel at Fukushima Daiichi NPP, who are required to work under high risk conditions, we recognize the need to take special measures such as establishing emergency medical response system.

We would appreciate your cooperation in dispatching medical doctors from your organization who could ensure the health care of personnel who work in the following conditions:

(22 Kitahara, Ottozawa, Okuma-town, Futaba-county, Fukushima)
2. Duration Unspecified until relief efforts are completed
