


Examples of Participatory Social Security (Positive Welfare) ④

Highly individualized support in accordance with the situation of job seekers aiming at creating a society where unemployed people can return to work as if bouncing on a trampoline

Work-life balance to eliminate the structure to choose either work or family life

Welfare/Nursing care

Comprehensive community care system that enables people even with dementia can live till the end of life in the local community by their own values

Necessary support for independent life in community and nursing equipment such as nursing robot

Measures for various daycare needs such as home-visit daycare service

Employment support which integrates welfare with employment

Pension, etc.

Support and promotion of employment while infallibly supporting the nation's life

- ③ Principle of clarification of burden and benefits
- ④ Principle of sustainability
- ⑤ Principle of no more missing pension records
- ⑥ Principle of elimination of no payment/non-participation
