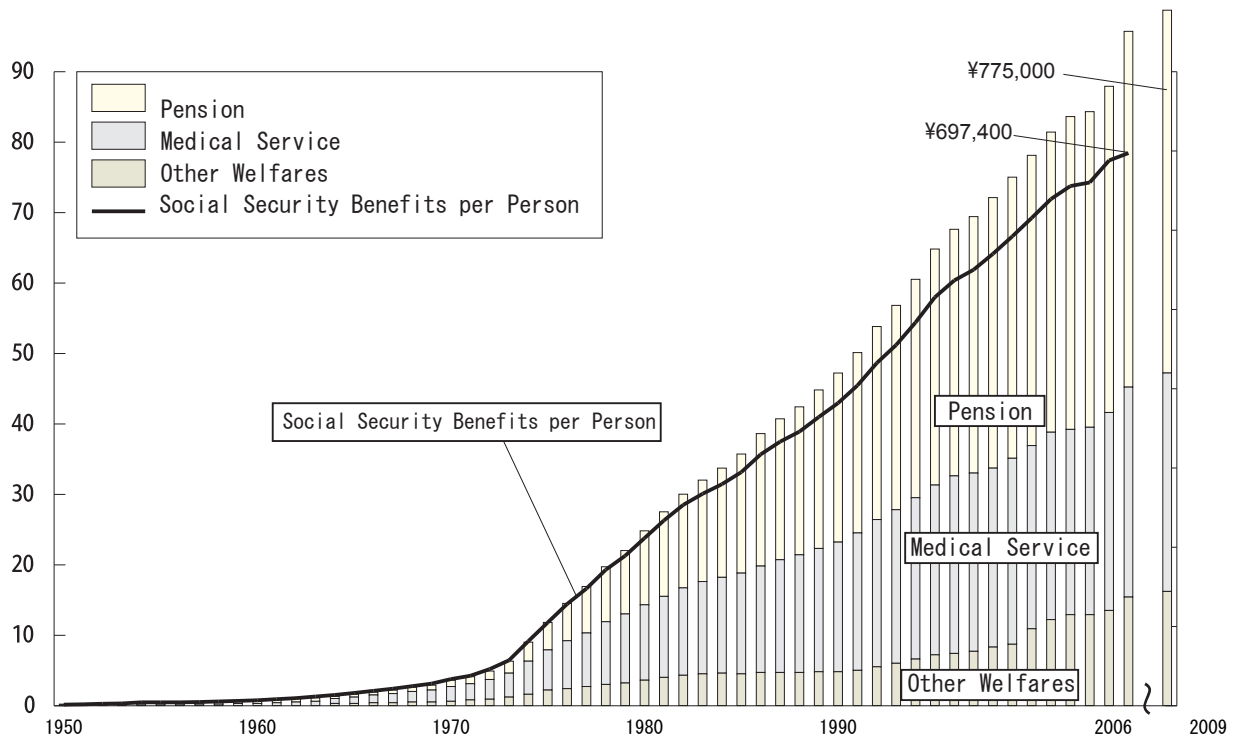


## Trends in Social Security Benefits
