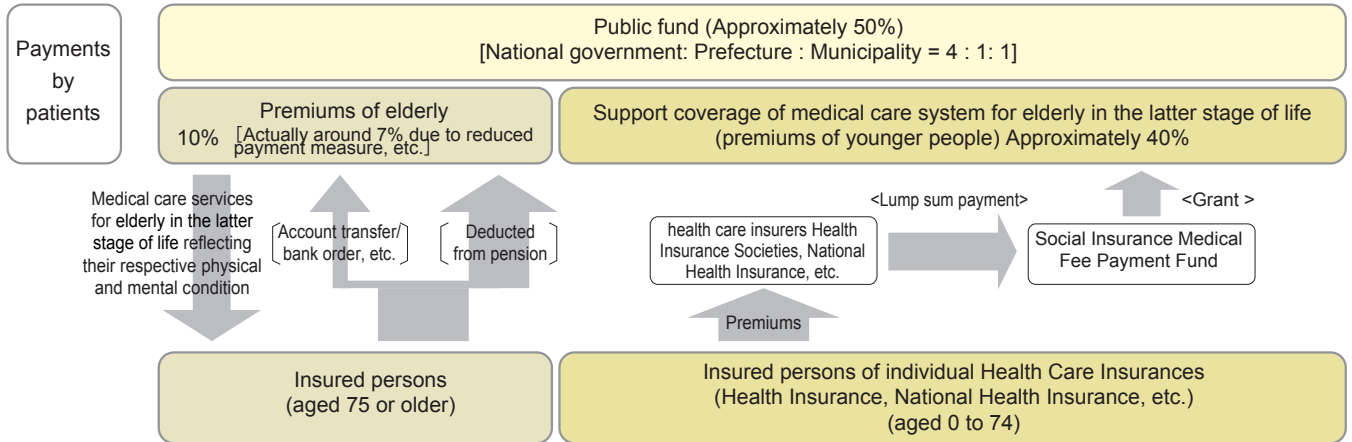


Detailed Information 2 Operation of long life medical care system (medical care system for elderly in the latter stage of life) (FY 2009)

<Number of subjects> Elderly aged 75 or older Approximately 14 million

<Medical care expenditure for elderly in the latter stage of life> ¥12.4 trillion (based on FY 2008 budget: full year)
Benefits expenditure ¥11.4 trillion Payments by patients ¥1.0 trillion

Note 1: For those earning full salaries, there are no public funded subsidies (50%) similarly to Health and Medical Service Act for the Aged, and thus the actual percentage of public funded subsidies is 47% and support coverage of medical care system for elderly in the latter stage of life is 43%.

Note 2: In regards to National Health Insurance and Support Coverage for Elderly in the Latter Stage of Life from Government-Managed Health Insurance, each has 50% and 16.4 % of public funded subsidies, and reduced premium payment for low-income people, etc. also receive public funded subsidies.
