## State of National Center for Advanced and Specialized Medical Care and National Hansen's Disease Sanatorium

[National Center for Advanced and Specialized Medical Care]

- ① There are 8 facilities of National Center for Advanced and Specialized Medical Care (so-called National Centers) and 4,959 beds nationwide (as of the end of FY 2008).
- ②National Center for Advanced and Specialized Medical Care was established as core institutions for development and dissemination of advanced and pioneering medical care, clarifying the cause and symptoms, development and research of new diagnosis and treatment methods, training for specialized medical professionals, and offering information in comprehensive and unified manner on diseases that constitute large percentages in the number of deaths, the number of patients, and medical expenditure in Japan include cancer, cerebral apoplexy, and heart diseases. Finding cures for such diseases has been a national issue.

National Cancer Center (1962), National Cardiovascular Center (1977), National Center of Neurology and Psychiatry (1986), International Medical Center of Japan (1993), National Center for Child Medical Health and Development (2002), and National Center for Geriatrics and Gerontology (2004) have been established.
