## (Explanation of terms)

### Numerical standards

Numbers of doctors and nurses to be deployed at hospitals designated by the Medical Care Act.

#### Conforming rate

"Percentage of hospitals satisfying the designated number of doctors/nurses" in "hospitals for which on-site investigation are conducted".

## Sufficient/insufficient

Of hospitals for which on-site investigation are conducted, those satisfying the numerical standards are counted as "sufficient" and those not satisfying the numerical standards are counted as "insufficient".
