Definition: Developmental disorders : Brain dysfunction that is generally expressed during earlier age such as pervasive developmental disorder(autism, etc.,) learning disability, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, etc.

After graduate age (middle-aged and young people)

- Early development support
 Early detection by health examination for infants
- Physical Examinations for Newly Enrolling Students
- Establishment of appropriate educational support and support system
- Use of after-school child sound upbringing services
- Specialized development support
- Achieve adequate employment opportunities according to the respective characteristics of people with developmental disorders
- Community life support
- Advocacy for the people with development disorders
