Overview Overview of the Welfare Volunteers and Child Welfare Volunteers

Welfare volunteers prescribed in the Commissioned Welfare Volunteers Law shall enhance social welfare with the spirit of social service, by providing consultation always from the people's viewpoints and giving necessary assistances; and by cooperating with works of government-affiliated organizations such as welfare office and like.

And the Welfare Volunteers shall double as the Child Welfare Volunteers provided for in the Commissioned Welfare Volunteers Law. The Welfare Volunteers shall grasp an appropriate perception of the environment surrounding and the lives of those people such as children in the communities, pregnant women and fatherless families. In the case children needing supports are found, Welfare Volunteers shall try to solve their problems by consultation and advice on the available service system.
