Overview

Minimum Wage System

1. Minimum wage system

The minimum wage system is a system that employers are obliged to pay employees the amount no less than the minimum wages formulated by the government in accordance with the Minimum Wages Act.

Even the cases where the wages below the minimum wage is stipulated in the conditions of agreement with employees are considered invalid and the amount equal to the minimum wage is considered applicable. Employers that failed to pay the regional minimum wage are punishable by a fine not exceeding ¥500,000.

2. Types of the minimum wage

Two types of the minimum wage exist, namely the "regional minimum wage" that applies to all workers in the region regardless of differences in industries and the "specific minimum wage" that is more expensive than the regional minimum wage and applies to workers in specific industries (electromechanical apparatus manufacturing, retail trade of motor vehicles, etc).

3. Wages subjected to the minimum wage

Wages subjected to the minimum wage are limited to those for regular working hours and days.

More concretely, the actual wages paid excluding the following wages are subjected to the minimum wage.

- (1) Extra wages (marriage allowance, etc)
- (2) Wages paid for a period that exceeds one month (bonuses, etc)
- (3) Wages paid for work performed outside the prescribed working hours (extra wages for overtime, etc)
- (4) Wages paid for work performed outside the prescribed working days (extra wages for holidays, etc.)
- (5) The portion of wages paid for work between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. that exceeds the total wages for regular working hours (extra wages for late-night, etc)
- (6) Full attendance allowance, commutation allowance, and family allowance
