III. SANITARY INFORMATION

1. The animal have been stored since birth in a place that is in a storage establishment meeting all of the following, that has been isolated from other areas, and in which there have been no other animals than such rodents.

a) Feeding control (hereafter including the management of records of the animals and their breeding, shipment and death) and sanitary control are carried out under the supervision of a committee consisting of concerned members including veterinarians in the establishment.

b) Appropriate measures are taken to ensure that the intrusion of animals from outside is prevented.

c) When introduced into the establishment, the animals are confirmed not to be contaminated with pathogens of infectious diseases in order to prevent the intrusion of pathogens of infectious diseases that may infect humans through animals.

d) Examinations are conducted periodically on the animals stored in the establishment to confirm they are not contaminated with pathogens of infectious diseases.

e) Information concerning the feeding and sanitary controls of the animals is recorded in documents and such documents are retained.

2. Since birth, the animals have not been used in any study with pathogens of infectious disease or have not come in contact with any animal used in such a study.

IV. TRANSPORT

The standards of the International Air Transport Association (IATA) Live Animals Regulations applicable to laboratory animals shipped under specific pathogen free (SPF) conditions must be respected.
